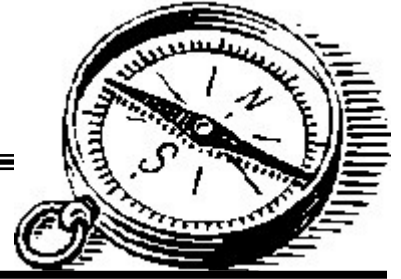
# HAPPY NEW YEAR

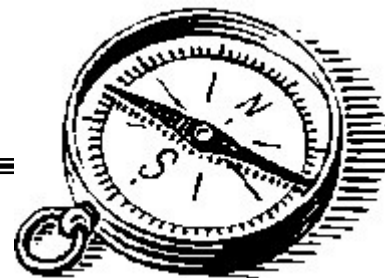
### What is God Doing?

### PARTNERS IN MINISTRY

“While the iron is hot...” let's go ahead and invite your church to consider serving as a “distribution point” for 2015 CFM Ministry! This year we actually had 6 of our member churches directly involved in distribution of toys and several people/groups from other churches that assisted. At least one church has expressed interest in serving as a distribution site in 2015—and we could use others!

Our goal is to strengthen the local church and impact lostness. Definitely engaging your church in ministry and missions could achieve both. We could use several other churches participating! We can say we assisted 150+ families, but we could assist more through our local churches. Divide into 150 the number of TRBA churches and you get fewer than 3 per church—and all our churches could minister to 3 families. And the impact that could be as you build relationship with the people in YOUR community.

TRBA could still serve as the screening and collection site to assist, but we ask that you prayerfully consider becoming involved with CFM in 2015. We will be making announcements early in 2015.

- ◆ ACP—BSCNC re-opened being able to file ACPs online but that opportunity ends 12/31/2014. We encourage all church clerks to file and make sure you hit save. - ◆ You will notice TRBA is not posting quarterly contributions in this newsletter. With the yearend activities and the closing of our books on January 7th, we will be getting that information to our churches during January. When you get notification of your church's contributions, we ask that you double-check the information to insure accuracy. We recognize there will be some variances simply due to when contributions are received in the mail at the office.

## How To Reach Your Neighbors

*Saturday, January 31st from 8:30 AM—11:00 AM TRBA will offer training sharing information and ideas about how to reach your neighbors. Our theme for the year—"to REACH them, we must KNOW them," emphasizes that we need to get to know our neighbors.*

*BSCNC offers a new tool available for member churches to help us better know the communities we serve. The tool is called MissionInsite and it will help you develop strategies specific to your church to minister to and share the Gospel with the people who live in the shadow of your steeple.*

*BSCNC has identified 250 "pockets of lostness." These are places where high percentages of people have no personal relationship with Jesus Christ. Certainly, most of those "pockets" are in more urban areas, but 3 of those "pockets" could be minister to by TRBA churches (3 mile circles in Franklinton, Sims, and Youngsville). Truthfully, there are pockets of lostness in every community that surrounds every church in TRBA!*

*Bring your laptop and a couple of key leaders in your church and begin to develop a strategy to reach your community.*

## REQUIREMENTS OF MEMBERSHIP

The Bylaws of the association have three basic requirements for membership in the association. As we begin the New Year, let's review them and perhaps explain a couple of things as people have questioned:

1. **Attendance at business meetings of the association:** Member churches should have messengers in attendance to at least one business meeting annually. Remember, we now only have the Spring and the Fall meetings.
2. **Contributing to the budget of the association:** The association encourages that member churches prayerfully consider contributing 5% of undesignated offerings to the association's budget to allow us to do the work you have determined we are to do as an association. **Please note: NO CP giving comes to the local association.**
3. **Complete the Annual Church Profile:** This enables us to have the current leadership of your church and get information to you better.
