Legal Rule for Designated Funds

Where funds are accepted subject to the donor's designation of the use of the funds, the church is under a legal duty to preserve those funds and use them only for the designated purpose. The church must be sure to separately account for these funds, and the actual money must be preserved, not merely a paper accounting. Thus the church should keep such designated funds in a separate account.
