TRBA CHURCHES SERVE CHILDREN, FAMILIES AT CHRISTMAS

Thanks in large part to the support of member churches and generous donors like Batchelor's Toy Run, TRBA was able to assist 11 churches in serving 269 children in 2023. Since 1990, Tar River Baptist Association has served over 5,000 families and 14,000 children in need of assistance at Christmas. Providing presents for children at Christmas provides churches with the opportunity to build a presence in their local community and to establish partnerships with local schools and organizations.
